

VILLAGE OF BRUCE RESOLUTION 19-01

**INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTION REGARDING
THE DISCONTINUANCE OF PUBLIC WAYS**

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Bruce in Rusk County, Wisconsin hereby introduces a resolution pursuant to Wis. Stat § 66.1003(4), to discontinue selected public ways originally laid in the Plat of Bruce, as more particularly described below; and

WHEREAS, the public ways proposed for discontinuance exist by virtue of a dedicated plat recorded with the Register of Deeds office for Rusk County; and

WHEREAS, the final resolution shall contain the following language:

“The Village Board of the Village of Bruce, Rusk County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the Village Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

The public ways contained in the parcels described below are vacated and discontinued under s. 66.1003 (4), Wis. Stats. It is in the public interest that the public ways described below are vacated and discontinued under s. 66.1003 (4), Wis. Stats. The public ways to be discontinued are located in part of the Plat of Bruce located in the SW ¼ of the NW ¼, and SE ¼ of the NW ¼, of Section 5, T.34 N., R.7 W., Rusk County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

THAT PORTION OF RAILWAY AVE. AS PLATTED, LYING BETWEEN THE EAST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF 1ST./ STREET A.K.A. 4TH./ STREET ON THE PLAT OF BRUCE AND THE EAST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF 2ND./ STREET A.K.A. 5TH./ STREET ON THE PLAT OF BRUCE AND THAT PORTION OF 2ND./ STREET A.K.A. 5TH./ STREET ON THE PLAT OF BRUCE, LYING BETWEEN THE NORTH LINE OF RIVER AVE. AND THE SOUTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF THE CANADIAN NATIONAL RAIL WAY:

MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED AS COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK 8, ALSO BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE N88°50'19"W ALONG THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF RIVER AVENUE, A DISTANCE OF 66.04 FEET TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 7; THENCE N00°40'29"W ALONG THE EAST LINE OF BLOCK 7 ALSO BEING THE WEST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF 2ND./ STREET, A DISTANCE OF 30.07 FEET, TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 7; THENCE S76°29'59"W, ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF BLOCK 7 ALSO BEING THE SOUTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF PLATTED RAILWAY AVENUE, A DISTANCE OF 118.75 FEET, TO THE SOUTH WEST CORNER OF BLOCK 7; THENCE N88°50'19"W ALONG THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF RIVER AVENUE, A DISTANCE OF 144.24 FEET, TO THE EAST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF 1ST./ STREET; THENCE N00°48'55"W, ALONG THE EAST RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF 1ST./ STREET, A DISTANCE OF 13.83

FEET, TO THE SOUTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF THE CANADIAN NATIONAL RAIL WAY; THENCE N76°29'59"E, ALONG THE SOUTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF THE CANADIAN NATIONAL RAIL WAY, A DISTANCE OF 334.33 FEET, TO THE EAST LINE 2ND./ STREET; THENCE S00°40'29"E, A DISTANCE OF 98.49 FEET, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

The discontinuance of the above-described public ways will not result in a landlocked property and no owner of property abutting the discontinued public ways will be damaged by the discontinuance. The discontinued public ways will be vacated and the land awarded to the following owner or owners of real estate abutting the discontinued ways:

- (i) Village of Bruce


The Village Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 61.50, Wis. Stats."

WHEREAS, a scale map of the lands that would be affected by the proposed discontinuances are attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BRUCE, RUSK COUNTY, WISCONSIN, AS FOLLOWS:


1. That a public hearing shall be held at the Village Hall for the Village of Bruce to determine whether discontinuing the above-described streets is in the public interest. Said meeting shall be held not less than 40 days after this resolution is introduced.
2. That notices of said public hearing required under Wis. Stat. § 66.1003(4)(b) shall be sent. At least 30 days prior to the hearing, said notices shall be served upon all owners of all lots fronting any of the roads proposed for discontinuance and a notice will be published as a class 3 notice under ch. 985. Any objection to the discontinuance by any owner must be made in writing and submitted to the Village Clerk for the Village of Bruce.
